Key Discussions and Progress

During the meeting, consortium members dove deep into the development of online training resources aimed at HVAC technicians.

The discussions centered around several important aspects of the project, including:

- Course Structure & Content: The consortium refined the online course for HVAC technicians, focusing on the basics of heat pump technology and its field applications. Partners are developing engaging materials to equip technicians with essential skills.
- **Internal Piloting & External Seminars:** Partners highlighted the need for internal piloting before launching the course, and discussed hosting external training seminars to reach a wider audience.
