Blockchain Skills Forecasting model

The CHAISE consortium has developed a Blockchain Skills Forecasting Model, which is a collaborative and data-based method for the anticipation of future blockchain skills demand and supply. It aims to act as an early warning and information mechanism, to mitigate possible labour market imbalances.

Annual report with Blockchain Skills Forecasts (2022)

This report applies the CHAISE Skills Forecasting model to estimate the current and future demand for blockchain skills, producing forecasts for the years to come (until 2026). The forecasts will enable the EU and member states to assess the extent to which skills mismatches are likely to occur in the short-term, which could inhibit the development of the blockchain sector.





CHAISE consortium partners in the spotlight

In this edition, get to know more about the Baden-Wuerttemberg Cooperative State University (DHBW), DIGITALEUROPE and the ECQA.



The [Baden-Wuerttemberg Cooperative State University \(DHBW\)](#) is Europe's first cooperative higher education system to integrate academic studies with workplace training within the curriculum. This means that students regularly switch, every three months, from their academic studies at the university to practical training at their partner company.

The research group [NextEducation](#), under the guidance of Professor Ulf-Daniel Ehlers, builds on vast experience in many European and international projects throughout the past decade concerning skill building and assessment, use of open educational resources and vocational recognition procedures in vocational and professional higher education contexts.

In CHAISE, DHBW is the leading partner for the Blockchain Skill Research, which is the basis for all further project activities (see [Blockchain Skill Mismatch Report](#)). Furthermore, the DHBW is also involved in other project steps, such as the creation of training materials for the acquisition of Blockchain skills.


DIGITALEUROPE

Backed by a large, continuously expanding European and international network of both industrial and academic experts, the ECQA fosters the elaboration and deployment of competence frameworks and skill cards, as well as their frequent adaptation to the rapidly evolving needs and requirements of the job market.

Based on these, the ECQA provides certification processes for currently more than 30 job roles in various domains.

In CHAISE, the ECQA provides as the European certification provider. It supports the development of learning outcomes and ensures compliance with CEDEFOP and ECVET principles. Further, the ECQA will develop a competence and skill validation methodology, recruiting external experts to assess practical exams and issue certificates. These will support modern certification requirements, such as modular certification through micro-based certification, as well as blockchain-based certification. Finally, the ECQA will define the EU-wide Blockchain skills requirements (incl. occupation card) and develop the blueprint for the establishment of a "European VET Providers Initiative"

SP21'2022: 2nd International Workshop on Security and Privacy in Intelligent Infrastructures


